Emergency echocardiography is a comprehensive echocardiographic study,⁷ which should also be distinguished from the focused cardiovascular ultrasound or examinations performed with pocket-size imaging devices (echo scanning), which may be a part of ...

Echo for the Assessment of Acute Chest Pain

- Echo can provide important information throughout the whole patient pathway, having been shown to change therapy in 60-80% of patients in the pre-hospital setting, - improve diagnostic accuracy and efficiency in the emergency room, - reveal the aetiology of unexplained hypotension in 48% of medical intensive care patients

What Is Echocardiography?

Echo tests are done by trained sonographers You may have your test done in your doctor's office, an emergency room, an operating room, a hospital

clinic or a hospital room • You'll lie on a bed on your left side or back • The sonographer will put special jelly on a probe and move it over your chest area

Role of Echocardiography in the Emergency Department

the emergency department, because of its rapid, accurate and repetitive image acquisition Echocardiography can detect coronary artery disease, complications of acute myocardial infarction, pericardial emergency, acute aortic diseases, and pulmonary embolic events, all of which may cause acute chest pain Depending on the clinical situation, stress
